Cabin, Tent and RV Campers

From Country Lake Road turn into Country Lake ENTRANCE #2

- RV Campers will be directed to the camping area by staff and will drive to that location. You will have a staff member waiting to help you get parked in a designated area in order to get set up. Please have at least one member of your family proceed to the Cabin Shelter to check your family in and pick up your welcome packet.
- Cabin Campers will be using our shower house located in Frontier Village which has 12 restrooms and 18 showers!
- Tent and RV campers will be using the Shower facilities at the New Cypress Dorm
- After getting checked in and getting settled, feel free to look around and explore a little. The basketball court (Sports Complex) is usually the hub of activity and might be a good place to start.
- Dinner is served from 5:30-6:45pm in the Corral
- You might think about taking your Bible and notebook as well as any belongings you will need for evening worship & outdoor activities.
- The first main session will be at 7PM in the Worship Center

Main Lodge/Hotel Campers

From Country Lake Road turn into the Main Entrance (Entrance #1) and veer left following the road to the top of the hill until you reach the Main Lodge. Pull right up to the front doors to unload (luggage carts are limited but available in the lobby)

- Check-in is located at the front desk (in lobby area)
- After unloading please park in the gravel lot or the lot nearest the lodge (South Lot)
- Once your family is settled into your lodging space, there will be a covered wagon or staff with golf carts making periodic runs to the Sports Complex. Please be sure to take your Bible with you as well as any belongings you will need for the evening worship/outdoor activities.
- Dinner is from 6-7pm in the Corral and the first session will be at 7PM in the Worship Center

Written Directions: *From Louisville Taking the East End Bridge:*

Take 265 North (Gene Snyder) crossing the East End Bridge

Take I-65 North toward Indianapolis. Take EXIT 19 (Henryville) and turn RIGHT at the end of the ramp.

Turn LEFT onto Hwy 31 at the four-way stop. Veer LEFT onto Brownstown Rd. Go 1.7 Miles and turn RIGHT onto Country Lake Rd. Country Lake will be on the left side of the road.



PACKING LIST

Just a note: Country Lake is a pet free, tobacco free, and alcohol free property (including e-cigs). Designated smoking areas are available in each parking lot if it is needed.

Below are listed a few suggested items that you should plan to pack in addition to typical clothing:

- Swimsuit (no bikinis or speedos please)*
- Sunscreen & Bug Spray*
- Sunglasses*
- Beach Towels and bath towels*
- Bible, notebook & pen*
- Mask (optional)*
- Camera or phone for pictures*
- Toiletries, including hair care and hair dryers*
- Bedding, sleeping bags, blankets, etc. (in hotel linens and towels are provided)*
- Flashlight*
- Light jacket or sweatshirt*
- Play clothes and shoes*
- Rain jacket or poncho in case of rain*
- Snacks, water bottles, etc. (some snacks will be provided each day but feel free to bring snacks your family enjoy)*
- We have decided to allow bikes and scooters again this year (nothing motorized). We will go over guidelines at the main session on Friday evening. The roadways are utilized by staff vehicles so we ask that anyone operating a bicycle can be aware of their surroundings and yield to other vehicles respectfully.*
- Cash for snack shack (credit card will only be taken at the merchandise tent in the worship center. Snack shack is cash and carry only – all items \$1)*
